Om Sai Welfare Association for the Blind and Disabled has been serving the disabled for the past eleven years under the guidance of Dr Dharmadhikari. The free residential computer centre run by the institute has trained 57 blind girls

until now. Approximately 18 girls from these have got employment in government and private sectors.
